Chief of Police, Waylin Bertrand announced that he is wanting to appoint Officer James Witherington as the Asst. Chief of Police. Motioned by Jeffcoats, second by Estay, and carried. Chief Bertrand let the council know that officer Jason Reeves passed his weapons and radar qualifications and will now be able to patrol. Chief Bertrand also wanted the council to be aware that he is still looking to hire a full-time officer for the nights position.
